

**Giving Thanks**

November marks at least two important *holidays* in American culture. Many of us will come together at the end of the month, gathering with friends and family, to celebrate Thanksgiving. The second *holiday*, celebrated with nearly just as much reverence, is the day-after-Thanksgiving, where crowds of people will cram department stores trying to get the best deal on Christmas presents. The fact that these two days occur right next to each other sends quite a message.

We live in a *me-centered* culture. Popular images, from billboards to music to television, tell us that we should be focused on ourselves. We should worry about how much money we make, what cars we drive, what toys we have, what clothes we wear, and what our body looks like. We join social clubs only as long as they benefit us. We let friendships go because they no longer serve our needs.

Religious and spiritual groups have grown-up feeding these obsessions. They tell us that if only we do enough praying, act the right ways, make the right decision, or write big enough checks to the church that God will reward us. It is a Me-God exchange. When it comes right down to it, these groups tell us that God is in the business of bartering. "OK, God, now this week I helped a lady cross the street, gave fifteen percent of my income to the church, and prayed every morning and every night, so now I should be set for awhile, right?" The problem with this thinking, in all its modern varieties, as Martin Luther discovered (well, it was just Reformation Day!), is that it becomes impossible to know when you've done enough to meet the bartering price to receive God's blessing. And so we are compelled to work harder and harder out of fear and despair that we may never do enough.

Paul writes that while we were still sinners, God proves God's love through Christ's death for us (Romans 5.8). There is no exchange rate; there is no fee on our side. It is simply God's love for us. It sounds impossible, it sounds too-good-to-be-true, and it sounds a little ridiculous. But, that's who God is. Without any requirement or fee, without any examination to see if we are good enough, God loves us and is with us through Christ and the Holy Spirit. This is why we give thanks, not just on one

day in November over too much food, but every day of our lives. Come to church, read the Bible, and hear the stories of God's acts of love without any prerequisites. Read especially this month Psalm 107. Hear how God answers and rescues even those who society says are the least worthy. And then pray. Pray to God who asks nothing of you, but invites you into a life-changing relationship with God and with one another. We are free to help out others, give our gifts to the work of the church, and other acts of charity, service, and love, not because we need to get something from God, but as a way of life lived in the mercy of God's grace. Now that's something to be thankful for.

**OLD BUSINESS**

**Education** – Sunday School is running smoothly.

We are looking for teachers to sign up for the year.

The Christmas program will be held on December 9

at the 9 o'clock service. Practice will be on December 8 from 9 a.m. to 11:45 a.m. with the Christmas lunch party following, ending about 12:30. There will possibly be 7 or 8 Sunday School students and 6 confirmands in the program. Ruth will handle the lunch.

**Worship** – The Praise Team has lost 4 members. They will carry on with their praise worship ministry and are still committed to the prison ministry at CVCTF.

December 2 is the first Sunday in Advent. Pastor will check on the Advent settings available for use in worship.

**Property** – The urinal in the men's room has had the handle to turn on the water modified so the water can be turned on and off without a stool. The water system problem will be tabled until it is checked out, with the possibility of an in-line filter being added to remove the sand from the whole system.

Dwight has purchased a new TV monitor. It needs to be installed.

The flooring border between the kitchen and the dining room will be replaced.

Monica and Dick Bahr will handle the mowing and cleaning up of the cemetery and lawn to be ready for the bazaar.

The music is lined up for the bazaar. The Roby Family, from the Eleva area, will do the music for a 10:00 service. Randy and Kay Sands will again do the chicken dinner. We will add dinner rolls and butter to the menu. They will get a Thrivent Community Impact Card (Seed Card) for the food. Outreach – Our booth at Cleghorn Harvest Fest was seen as a success and something to be repeated next year. A booth with some information on the church, a chance to buy raffle tickets for prizes at the bazaar, and a couple games for kids, especially the balloon pop, with prizes, went over well.

**Bazaar** – We will have the refrigerator magnets about our church available at the bazaar. Kay has the Thrivent Community Impact Card for the dinner. One thought on the profits from the meal is to send it to the Coon Valley Flooding, if there is a fund. Kay will research the "Fight the Flood" program that was highlighted on TV.

The Joe Roby Family does not charge for their performance or for their CDs. We will supply a free chicken dinner for the family. We mentioned having a free will offering for the family as well. The letter to the neighbors, the prayer chain, and the congregational study information dissemination are all on hold.

Committees are not currently being formed as such. We will form various committees as needed.
